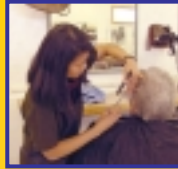

Accommodation

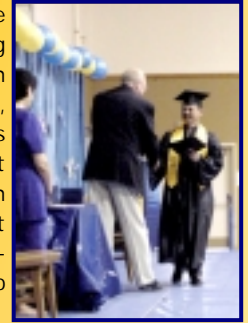
Adult accommodation in Birchwood Hall is based on double occupancy; costs are \$300 per month for room; \$300 for meals provided at the PERS dining hall.
